Abuse Trauma Variables

'To date, investigators have largely considered each type of abuse and its severity in isolation, rather than examining these variables as interactive factors' Frank Putnam *

- the detailed nature of the child's attachment to his or her parents ٠
- the age and developmental level of the child at its onset ۰
- its duration and frequency •
- whether different form of abuse coexist •
- the relationship of the child to the abuser(s) ٠
- the type and severity of the abusive acts •
- the existence of multiple abusers ٠
- the degree of physical violence and aggression used •
- the age and gender of the offender •
- the existence of peer or adult supports •
- whether or not the child has been able to tell ٠
- the parental reaction to the disclosure •
- the 'institutional' response •
